Dear Sir/Madam

With this letter, we invite you to be tested for fecal occult blood.

The test is free of charge as is any further investigation.

To join the invitation:

- BE PRESENT WITH THIS LETTER and YOUR HEALTH CARD at a pharmacy, where you can pick up the kit for performing the test.
- Collect the sample, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, following the INSTRUCTIONS you will find attached, write.NAME, SURNAME and DATE OF BIRTH on the writable part of the tube label.
- The sample can be stored in the refrigerator for up to 48 hours.
- Go to one of our collection points at the times indicated and DEPOSIT THE SAMPLE IN THE DEDICATED CONTAINER:

1. Sampling room/Old Hospital of IMOLA.

From Monday to Saturday, 7,00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

2. Concierge desk CASTEL SAN PIETRO TERME House of Health.

From Monday to Friday, 7,00 a.m. to 1,00 p.m. - Saturday, 7,00 a.m. to 12,00

3. Concierge Desk House of Health MEDICINE

From Monday to Friday, 7,00 a.m. to 1,00 p.m. - Saturday 7,00 a.m. to 10,00 a.m.

4. BORGO TOSSIGNANO District - Via dell'8° Centenario, 4

From Monday to Friday, from 7,00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. - Saturday from 7,00 a.m. to 9,00 a.m.

If the test is negative the result will be sent to your home or on FSE and we will invite you to repeat the test in 2 years, in

case of positivity (presence of blood in the stool) you will be contacted by phone by the Screening Center who will give you

information about the planned further investigations.
